- The SGS working party have met and will be planting wild flowers this weekend. They will also be planting hops to screen the water treatment plant. Wayland Partnership are providing tools and safety equipment. The risk assessments are being created by the working party.
- CS is contacting the head teacher of the local school to arrange access to the tree nursery.
